- 1. To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in the breed and have the support of The Rottweiler Breed Council (KC Policy)
- 2. To have judged a minimum of 120 Rottweilers and to include a Breed Club Open Show
- 3. To have judged the breed at a minimum of 15 Open shows and to have judged no less than 50 classes with dogs present to include a Breed Club Open Show or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread
- 4. To have attended a K.C. Seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures (KC Policy as of 01.07.2001)
- To have attended a K.C. Seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement (KC Policy as of 07.07.2001)
- 6. To have attended a points of the dog assessment conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment (KC Policy as of 01.07.2005)
- To have attended at least one Breed-specific Rottweiler Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment.(KC Policy as of 01.07.2001)
- 8. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book.(Save in exceptional circumstances) (KC Policy)
- 9. To have Stewarded a minimum of 12 days at Open or Championship shows (KC Policy) (A copy of your detailed and signed stewards record book must be sent in with your application)
